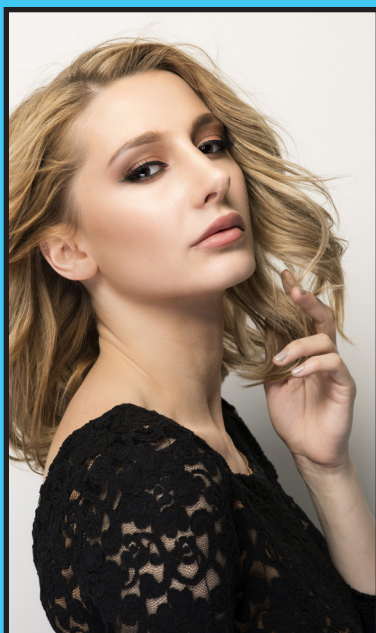
Course Intakes
